RUFFORTH IN THE RAIN by T.SYKES.

On Saturday June 27th the Ouse Gliding Club held an open day & air display at R.A.F. Rufforth. Despite the rain which fell all afternoon the display went ahead.

The opening event was a flypast by Vulcan XL443 from Waddington closely followed by a longer demonstration by Lancaster PA474 'KM-B' also from Waddington. The Fournier RF4 G-AWGO and RF5 G-AYAI then gave an aerobatic show which led into a flour bombing display by Turbulent G-AWPA, Tiger Moth G-AODS, Currie Wot G-APNT, and J3C Cub G-ATKI. After this the Tiger stayed airborne for solo aerobatics. The next item was a Slingsby T.53B demonstration. The T.53B was unregistered but carried the c/n 1721 & Terrier G-ASAJ was used as aerotow. Cessna 150 G-ATMB then did a short take off and landing before the "Ravens" parachute team did a free fall from Cherokee Six G-AWCY. Synchronised aerobatics followed, performed by "The Blue Chips" from 2FTS Church Fenton in Chipmunks WP831/21 and WK514/6. The next event was of great historical importance, the sole remaining Blackburn B2, G-AEBJ, took to the air for an aerobatic display 38 years to the day after the first public appearance of the prototype B2 at the S.B.A.C. Show at Hendon on June 27th 1932. After a display by radio controlled models G-ASAJ was put to use again, this time towing off Olympia 2B BGA1128/428 for more aerobatics. Currie Wot G-APNT continued the display with an aerial limbo act and the SF.25B Motorfalke G-AXEO was put through its paces. The Turbulent G-APYZ then took to the air flown by Britain's oldest Pilot, Mr. J. Gladish, and whilst he was flying a unique manpowered aircraft built by Mr. B. Crocker of the Ouse Gliding Club was wheeled out in front of the crowd. By this time however the rain was so heavy that no attempt was made to fly it and the display was terminated. Gliders which were on display but did not fly were Skylark 2B BGA845/217, Skylark 3B BGA870/101, Swallow BGA1338/478, T.21B BGA1110, T.49A Capstan BGA1009/491, Olympia 2B BGA1386/117, K6e BGA1507/144. During the display Phoebus 'C' BGA1573/95 arrived in its coffin and was assembled and parked amongst the other gliders.

Cub F-BGQD has been sold to a Mr. Gladish who was the owner of Turbulent G-APYZ, which has been taken in part exchange by General Air Services. The Cub is now registered as G-AYEN. General Air Services have also been busy in respect of Auster j/4 G-AIJM which they have sold to a new owner at Netherthorpe.

Jodel G-AXVS has now been sold and left Sherburn on 5.7.70 to its new owner at Rochester.

The Yorkshire Territorial Flying Group air day was held at Sherburn on 5.7.70. As usual the weather was kind and aviators duly arrived in the competitive spirit, this was best shown by the one hundred and twenty attempted landings being made in the Spot landing competition. The eventual winner of this event was David Blackburn in the Turbulent G-APYZ who narrowly won after a fly-off.

The flour bombing event also proved to be very exciting although it was marred by the sudden appearance of Ted Dawson in his Falco G-AVUJ with part of his stbd. wing and aileron missing. His landing was perfect though and brought a round of applause from a relieved crowd.

Further tragedy struck during this event when Mr. Slater in the Clubs Tiger Moth G-AODS Crashed. Although the aircraft is a write off both Mr. Slater and his passenger were only slightly injured. The flour bombing event was finally won by Messrs Holmes and Robinson in Cessna 150 G-ATNC.

Concourse D'Elegance was splendidly judged by members of the West Riding Branch of Air Britain, who, despite various bribes and fights within its ranks came to the decision that Mr. A. Fox with his superbly turned out Cherokee 180 G-AVSE was the winner. Special mention should be made of Stampe G-AXJT and Cessna 150 G-ATKE, both of which were in the running but due to the recent overhaul of both machines Mr. Fox's Cherokee took the prize, being the only one of the three aircraft in its original state.

Displays during the day were given by Cessna FA.150 N8308M, 150 G-ATHV, F.150 G-ATMK, and Stampe G-AXJT all of which were of a very high standard.

Cessna 150 G-AYEY was delivered to Northair on 28.6.70 and flown to Ashford 3.7.70. Musketeer G-AWFZ was taken in part exchange.

Viscount G-AVIY was broken up in June, the first visible damage was noted on the 3rd June, 1970 when the tail section was chopped off.

On display at the Doncaster Trades Fair between June 6th to 13th was Drone XT851. On the c/n plate were two sets of numbers, 214/68600-507 and KK/T/38/CB25(B). If they mean anything to anyone, the editor would like to hear from you.

At Tholthorpe resident Minicab G-AWWM was joined on 5.5.70 by Nipper G-AVTB.

Cessna F150G G-AWES arrived at Y.L.A. on approx. 5.6.70 in a bent condition.

At Doncaster Condor G-AWFP has been replaced by G-AWST. The remains of G-AWFP have been removed by Rollasons.

B.K.S. Air Transport will now be known as Northeast Airlines and will trade as Northeast. The change has been made to reflect the carriers relationship with the Northeast of England, the main trunk route being London to Newcastle. There is a possibility that there will be confusion with the U.S. airline of the same name but the Airline consider that the risk is worth taking.

American Aviation have appointed General Aviation Services of Jersey as U.K. distributor for the Yankee two seater light aircraft. The company expects to sell about 50 in all this year and a further 100 in 1971. All aircraft shipped in 1970 will be assembled by Eagle Aviation Services at Leavesden. American Aviation will be seeking to establish a major European assembly point which will receive aircraft in a less finished state than those at present being shipped. These are being flown at Cleveland before being dismantled for shipment. There are distributors in eight European Countries.
